

The following changes were made to the proposed Constitution by the Congregational Council as a result of discussions from the Congregation forum held on August, 22nd. They are reflected in the final proposed Constitution.

Originally proposed:

C8.05.01 A confirmed member who does not, for a period of one year, partake of Holy Communion, support the church with their offerings, and does not appear to desire to participate in the life and worship of the congregation shall be visited by the pastor and/or a representative of the congregation and encouraged by them to active membership. If, during the second year, the confirmed member does not actively participate, their name shall be removed from the **active** membership roster of the congregation.

Change to:

C8.05.01 A confirmed member who does not, for a period of one year, partake of Holy Communion, support the church with their offerings, and does not appear to desire to participate in the life and worship of the congregation shall be visited by the pastor and/or a representative of the congregation and encouraged by them to active membership. If, during the second year, the confirmed member does not actively participate, their name shall be removed from the **voting** membership roster of the congregation

Originally proposed:

C11.01.01 The duties of the officers shall be as follows;

- A. The president shall preside at all meetings of the Congregation Council called congregational meetings.

Change to:

C11.01.01 The duties of the officers shall be as follows;

- A. The president shall preside at all meetings of the Congregation Council **and** called congregational meetings.

Originally proposed:

C13.04. A **Mutual Ministry Committee** shall be appointed jointly by the president and the pastor. Term of office shall be two years, three members to be appointed annually.

Change to:

C13.04. A **Mutual Ministry Committee** of six congregational members, none of which shall be council members. Members will serve a two-year term; three members to be appointed annually. The committee shall be appointed by the pastor and the Congregation Council President and shall be ratified by the congregation council. The primary function of this group is to evaluate the work and ministry of the church as well as supporting the pastor

Originally proposed:

C13.06. Other committees of this congregation may be formed, as the need arises, by decision of the Congregation Council.

Change to:

C13.06. Other committees of this congregation may be formed, as the need arises, by decision of the Congregation Council. Such committees shall present a written report to the Congregation Council at least 5 days prior to the monthly council meeting.
